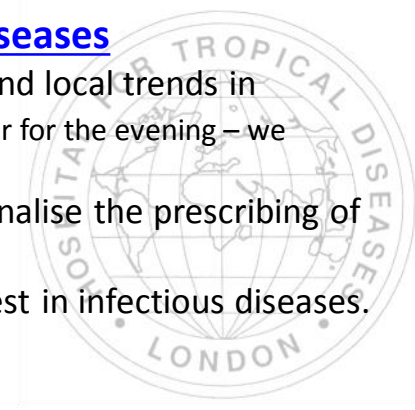


## Thursday 19<sup>th</sup> June 2014: Microbiology and Paediatric Infectious Diseases
