



PROGRAMME: Thursday 21st November **Mental health in travellers and migrants**

The first half of this session will focus on psychiatric presentations of infectious diseases. We will also discuss common scenarios in primary care: delusional parasitosis, anti-malarials used in patients with a mental health history, and how Chronic Fatigue and Lyme disease can often present in similar ways.

In the second half of our session Dr Derek Summerfield will be challenging the application of Western mental health concepts to global populations. Dr Summerfield has been principal psychiatrist at the Foundation for Victims of Torture and is now an Honorary Senior Lecturer at the Institute of Psychiatry.
