This evening we will be discussing the popular topic of skin conditions in migrants and travellers, which takes up a large proportion of primary care consultations.

Our first speaker is **Dr Sara Ritchie, a GPwSI in dermatology at UCLH**. She will be discussing how common skin conditions and their management can vary between different skin types, thus tailoring your knowledge to your migrant population.

In the second half of our seminar **Prof Diana Lockwood, Consultant in Infectious Diseases & Tropical Medicine at UCLH**, will be discussing how to diagnose, manage, and when to refer common skin infections, as well as rashes presenting in the returning traveller or migrant.

We will also be discussing the management of cellulitis in primary care, and what local services/clinics are available to manage the more difficult cases of cellulitis.
